



## ECE Graduation Checklist, page 2

### Definitions:

a. "Term" means term during which you took the course (e.g. FA 09, SP 13, SU 11).
b. "LS" means liberal studies.
c. "AAE" means advisor-approved elective.
d. "CDE" means culminating design experience.
e. "4000+" means a technical ECE elective at the 4000-level or above
f. "3000+" means a technical ECE elective at the 3000-level or above.
g. "OTE" means Outside-ECE Technical Elective.

### Notes:

<sup>1</sup> Six <b>LS</b> courses totalling at least 18 credits and covering at least three categories are required, including at least two courses at the 2000-level or above. Indicate categories in the Cat. column.
<sup>2</sup> At least 6 credits of <b>AAE</b> courses are required.
<sup>3</sup> <b>ECE 2100, 2200, and 3400</b> are required.
<sup>4</sup> Of the <b>ECE foundation</b> courses ECE 3030, 3100, 3140, and 3150, and 3250 you must take at least three, including at least one of ECE 3100 and ECE 3250 and at least one of ECE 3030 and ECE 3150.
